

Admission Policy – Music in the Park

Advance tickets are available from: **Thame Town Hall, Wally's Toy Shop, Vintage and Modern Guitars, Fore Golf, the Florence Nightingale Shop, the Falcon pub and the Cross Keys pub.**

Tickets prices on the day of the event will be: Family Ticket **£28**; Adult **£12**; Senior Citizens / Students (with valid ID) / 18 and under **£6**. Identification may be required when purchasing and upon entry.

Under-5s **Free**. Proof of date of birth may be required when purchasing and upon entry.

Although this is a family-friendly event, no one under the age of 16 may purchase a ticket or attend unless they are accompanied by an adult.

Tickets are non-returnable. Refunds will only be available if the event is cancelled or entirely rescheduled. The performers and advertised attractions are subject to change. In the event of inclement weather, certain activities and stages may need to be closed.

Holders of tickets purchased online will be admitted through the main entrance from Park Street only.

The organisers will not issue duplicate tickets for lost or stolen tickets.

On the day of the event there will be no entry before 11.30am or after 8.30pm.

A wrist-band will be issued on arrival at the site; there will be no automatic right of re-admission during the event should the wristband become lost or damaged.

Organisers reserve the right to ask for proof of entry. If nothing is produced the person will be required to purchase a ticket or be removed from the site.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse admission to the event. Random body searches may be carried out. It is a condition of entry to the event that you will submit to any reasonable search request.

Illegal substances are strictly prohibited at the event. Any person in possession of such substances will be denied entry and/or removed from the event, and the police will be called to attend.

Purchasing alcohol for under-18s is illegal. Disregard of this will result in confiscation of the alcoholic beverage and possible ejection from the site.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse admission if you are considered to be under the influence of intoxicating liquor.

The organisers cannot accept liability for any damages, loss or injuries sustained at the event, including loss or damage to property, howsoever caused.

Tickets are sold on the understanding that the event is subject to licence from the appropriate authorities.

Tickets are not transferable.

No dogs allowed (except assistant dogs).

NO BBQs AND NO GLASS ARE ALLOWED ON SITE.

The organisers request that all visitors respect the local environment and exercise a basic standard of decent behaviour so that we may all enjoy ourselves without upsetting local residents.
